Distributors must have awareness – anidaho – of the perverse nature of the whites and their offspring, their culture and their false religions and reject them fully without compromise.

Prospective distributors can place an order and begin studying the e-book versions of our books while awaiting the first shipment. Individuals must review each of the works at least
